INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR INTERNSHIP

The Commission is an entity established under Article 59(4) of the Constitution and the Commission on Administrative Justice Act, 2011. The Commission has a mandate, *inter-alia*, to investigate any conduct in state affairs or any act or omission in public administration in any sphere of Government and complaints of abuse of power, unfair treatment, manifest injustice or unlawful, oppressive, unfair or unresponsive official conduct. Further, the Commission is the oversight agency on the right to access to information as provided for by the Access to Information Act, 2016.

In the conduct of its functions, the Commission has powers to conduct investigations on its own initiative or on a complaint made by a member of the public, issue summons and require that statements be given under oath, adjudicate on matters relating to administrative justice and access to information, obtain relevant information from any person or Governmental authorities and to compel production of such information.

The Commission seeks to recruit **one (1) LEGAL INTERN** for its vacant internship position **Kwale Huduma Centre**.
